**Boulder City Police
Investigate Roll-Over Accident**

On October 29, 2009 at approximately 1:30 p.m., a three vehicle traffic accident occurred at the US 93 and US 95 Interchange. A black Chrysler PT Cruiser was northbound on US 93 approaching US 95 at a high rate of speed when it came upon a silver Ford Focus. According to witness statements, the Chrysler attempted to pass the Ford on the inside emergency lane before re-entering the travel lane and causing the collision.

The front passenger side of the Chrysler struck the left side of the Ford, causing the Ford to swerve into the outside travel lane, striking a Nissan Sentra. The Chrysler then swerved out of the travel lane and onto the dirt median before rolling multiple times and coming to rest on its passenger side. The driver of the Chrysler was ejected from the vehicle and transported to Sunrise Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The remaining vehicles' occupants were treated and released at the scene.

The accident remains under investigation by the Boulder City Police Department Traffic Section.
