PINK NOTICE INSERTED WITH ABSENTEE MAIL BALLOTS SHOULD BE DISREGARDED

Some of you may be aware of a pink notice that was inserted into the absentee mail ballots that erroneously indicated a voter was allowed to vote for one candidate in each contest. This notice is auto-inserted by the Clark County Election Department for other municipalities and should have been pulled for Boulder City's election, as we do not have wards.

Larry Lomax, Clark County Registrar of Voters, has mailed out a letter to each absentee mail ballot recipient indicating the notice was mistakenly enclosed. He stated, as indicated on the Sample Ballot, **YOU CAN VOTE FOR TWO CANDIDATES FOR CITY COUNCIL.**

If you have already voted and mailed your ballot back to the Election Department, and did not vote for two candidates for City Council Members At Large, please contact the Election Department at 455-6552 and they will send you a new ballot.

As always, you may choose to surrender your ballot and cast your vote on a machine at the Early Voting site at City Hall or at your polling place on Election Day.
